## **Footnotes**

ARIETTA was well placed just off the pace on the inside, drafted along the hedge on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, chased under a strong hand ride, came off the inside before the furlong marker, gained the lead at the sixteenth-pole and proved best under a brisk hand ride. WANTAGH QUEEN settled in the middle of the field, went three wide on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, floated six wide into the stretch, was put to a left-handed whip at the three-sixteenths and finished well to get the place. GLARE ICE was sent hard from the start, went to the front and set the pace, vied in the two path for most of the turn, dropped close to the hedge approaching the quarter-pole, was asked after straightening for the drive, led under a strong hand ride into the final furlong, was collared at the sixteenth-pole then was caught for the place. SCOUT IT OUT was hustled from the start, chased the pace, dropped

back some leaving the backstretch, was ridden along in the two path on the turn, angled out inside the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. SPLENDID GOLD settled off the pace, went around the turn in the two path, bumped lightly with DULCE DE LECHE nearing the five-sixteenths, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under a strong hand ride in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip at the furlong marker and finished willingly to just miss the last spot in the superfecta. SANFIERA settled in the front half of the field, was urged along while three wide on the turn, chased under a drive in upper stretch and also lacked the needed kick. JAMAALAREE broke very fast, chased the pace on the outside, vied three then two wide on the turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong then was switched to a right-handed whip and weakened. NORTHERN ANALYST was hustled from the gate, settled on the far outside, was urged along while three wide on the turn and failed to rally. SHEEPISH hit the gate at the start and broke a bit slow, settled at the back while on the outside, went four wide on the turn, drifted inward in upper stretch and failed to threaten. STREET LASS broke a bit slow, was reserved at the rear, went around most of the turn in the two path, shifted to the three path outside the quarter-pole, came between horses in upper stretch, lugged in slightly and was no factor. DULCE DE LECHE settled on the inside, bumped lightly with SPLENDID GOLD outside the half-mile pole, hesitated outside the quarter-pole while still along the hedge, was roused at the quarter-pole and failed to respond. HONEYCHILD settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and had nothing left.
