SINFULLY saved ground around the first turn, stalked the pace inside a rival down the backstretch, remained just off the wood around the second turn, came out in the stretch, battled between three wide in the final furlong and was up for the show. PERSUASIVE PAUL dueled for the lead on the outside down the backstretch and around the second turn, continued to battle for the lead in the final furlong and steadied when crowded late. SQUARE DANCER stalked the pace outside a rival down the backstretch, bid three wide on the second turn and steadied in close quarters between horses leaving the sixteenth marker. JOVITA'S TUFFY chased outside the winner down the backstretch and around the second turn, came into the lane four wide and lacked a rally. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident between the winner and SQUARE DANCER in the stretch but made no change when they ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.

LUCKY COTTON pulled his way along to stalk the pace a bit off the rail then between horses approaching and on the turn, continued off the fence into the stretch and was outfinished. MAJOR TRUTH settled off the rail then outside, angled in on the turn, came out in upper stretch and bested the others.
