HOTHALFONE was urged to a position three deep in the second flight in the opening stages, continued in that path while making a steady bid racing into the stretch, couldn't menace the winner but proved best of the others. HUSH MY MOUTH broke slowly, was urged to contend four wide racing into the turn but lacked the needed closing bid. HEY I KNOW YOU, caught outside foes in the opening stages, angled inwards entering the turn to pursue the leader between foes racing into the turn but steadily faded entering upper stretch. PLAYITAGAIN HOWIE settled between foes in the last flight early and never gained contention. MOE'S FAVORITE CAT, a bit reluctant to load, flashed brief pace between foes in pursuit of the eventual winner, checked while going a bit awkwardly racing into the turn and had no further response. THORSON chased the leader along the rail as part of the second flight in the opening stages but retreated early.

I'M OLD SCHOOL broke sharply, moved away to a clear advantage, dictated the pace off the rail under rating racing into the turn, then extended the advantage racing into the stretch when given his cue to prove best under pressure. SACRED RANGE was reserved off the second flight in early stages racing along the rail, was shuffled a bit avoiding close quarters approaching the turn, angled five wide midstretch while gaining some momentum and prevailed for place honors in the closing stages. TRAVEL REQUIRED, in touch with the first flight between foes in the opening stages, was eased off those foes while angling to the rail racing into the bend, saved ground to upper stretch and prevailed for a share while making an even effort. RAFFIE'S DELIGHT chased the pacesetter four wide racing into the turn, continued in that path to upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. J. Z.'S CRAFTY BOY switched off the inside chasing the pacesetter between foes in the second flight early and steadily faded between rivals in the last furlong. IOLANDA'S PERFECT settled between foes dropping off the second flight early and made no impression on the leaders thereafter. FAITHFUL SERVANT angled inside early tracking the leaders outside a rival racing into the turn but never gained contention. INDIAN BEAR SOUP broke slowly and trailed throughout.

TACOMA PARK moved to the fore inside foes to dictate the pace on a narrow margin under light rating while racing a bit off the rail, edged forward nearing upper stretch, then continued with a steady late response to hold safe the challenge of SHOBIZ STAR through the stretch to prevail under firm handling. The latter, forwardly placed three deep between foes tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the turn, angled to the rail midway through the bend continuing with a steady bid, was urged to challenge for command inside the leader racing through the stretch and continued willingly to dispute the issue to the end while just failing to gain even terms with the winner. BROAD CONVICTION, a bit outpaced in early stages, angled four wide racing into upper stretch and found his best stride late to gain position while prevailing for a share. CAPPUCCINO CAT, held up in the opening stages while switching outside foes, was urged to gain contention racing four wide into the bend, briefly drew into striking distance in that path after a half but flattened out leaving midstretch. YA MON, in touch prompting the pacesetter between foes racing into the turn, emptied out after a half. DISORDERLY CONDUCT shifted off the inside early to race between foes tracking the leaders out of striking and never gained contention. BROCKET was guided to the rail in early stages but never gained contention.

SUNDAY CHOIR was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the turn and gave way near midstretch. CRIMINAL ELEGANCE settled between foes in early stages, angled out four wide racing into the stretch to gain some position but made no real impression. FEATHERINTHEBREEZE tracked the leaders along the inside as part of the second flight racing into the bend and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. QUEEN OF CLUBS was never a factor. I TURNED OUTLAW showed little.
