MY MOMENT settled between foes in early, angled four wide racing into upper stretch, continued evenly in that path to gain a share, fell to the track when returning to be unsaddled but recovered to regain her footing under her own power and was vanned off the course. TANGUERAY MISS settled into stride off the inside early but never gained contention. LOOK WHO'S HERE was urged to the lead inside the eventual winner in the opening stages but gave way after three furlongs. LADY'S DAY OFF angled to the inside tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance early but steadily faded racing into the bend.

CANDY CHANT took up a tracking position racing three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch, was bumped entering the far turn while being prompted to advance on the leader in tandem with a rival, continued with a steady bid to gain the advantage midstretch but couldn't quite fend off the winner. MANET broke readily, was rated between foes in the second flight tracking the leader, shifted out entering the far turn making some contact with CANDY CHANT while being prompted to advance, bid in tandem with that foe to challenge for command racing into upper stretch but weakened along the inside in late stages. WEALTH MANAGEMENT tracked off the second flight a bit off the inside in early stages, shifted out racing into the lane and made some mild progress while just missing for a share. MUZZAZ was roused from the break to secure the lead, set the pace on a clear margin into the far turn and emptied out abruptly once headed racing into upper stretch. SIR KIPLING tracked the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight in the opening half and steadily faded racing through the far turn.
